***Additional Information:*** Queen Anne house of ca. 1890 has a shingled exterior, a side tower, and a veranda extending into a porte-cochere. Hume was not only in Real Estate and Insurance but was also one of the founders of the Marshfield News. Joseph C. Marsh, founder of the Marshfield Telephone Exchange, lived here around 1921—1939. The home was also owned by Dr. Macht and later some time between 2005 and 2010, remodeled with an addition and a new garage. The home was also called the “Tower” or the 3-story tower.
