Contemporary Style homes are characterized by various types of windows, their lack of ornamentation, and their unusual mixtures of wall materials like stone, brick, and wood, for instance. Architects designed Contemporary-style homes (in the Modern family) between the end of the 20th century into the present, and created two versions: the



flat-roof and gabled types. The latter is often characterized by exposed beams. Both breeds tend to be one-story tall and were designed to incorporate the surrounding landscape into their overall look. This house features a free play of volumes with opposing shed roofs, a second story with clerestory windows, and ribbon windows facing the garden.
