*The Four Seasons Antique Mall has occupied the “Weber Building” at the corner of Fourth and South Central Avenue since 1988, when she bought the building from the Weber Brothers.*

*As you enter the rounded double door corner entrance you will be embraced with two levels of room-like settings filled with antiques. Four Seasons is Central Wisconsin’s largest antique mall with 6,000-square feet of top quality antiques.*
