Born out of the fundamental need for shelter, National-style homes, whose roots are set in Native America and pre-railroad dwellings, remain unadorned and utilitarian. The style is characterized by rectangular shapes with side gabled roofs or square layouts with pyramidal roofs. The gabled-front-and-wing style pictured here is the most prevalent



type with a wing attached at a right angle. National style homes, are characterized by layouts that are two rooms wide and one room deep. You'll find National homes throughout the country.
