

Louis C. Schmidt, Monuments– 435 South Central Avenue

The three cemeteries of Marshfield are dotted with magnificent monuments in the skill and industry of Louis C. Schmidt, proprietor of the Marshfield Marble works. Nearly all the monuments in these silent resting places have been wrought and placed by Mr. Schmidt and it may be said to his credit that few cities of the size have as handsome monuments in their cemeteries as Marshfield.

The stock of marble and granite at the Marshfield Marble Works on Central Avenue, is probably the largest in this section of the state and Mr. Schmidt uses excellent judgment in the selection of his material. The polishing, carving and lettering are all done here under the watchful eye of the proprietor and nothing but the highest class of work is turned out. Mr. Schmidt has been in this business here since 1894 and has an excellent reputation as an artist and a reliable business.
